A special meeting of the Council of the City of Lebanon, Pa., was held in Council Chamber of the Municipal Building, Lebanon, Pa., this evening, Chairperson Carey presiding.

The meeting was called to order at 4:46 p.m.

Present--Mr. Miller, Mr. Morales, Mr. Wertz, and Mr. Carey, Chairperson--4. Absent--none.

Also present were Mayor Sherry L. Capello; Chief of Police Todd Breiner; Donna Long Brightbill, City Solicitor; Janelle Mendoff, Director of Community and Economic Development; Melissa Quinones, Director of Administration-Assistant to the Mayor; Fire Commissioner Duane Trautman; three persons in the audience; and one member of the news media.

Chairperson Carey called for nominations to fill the vacancy on Council.

Dan Bost was nominated to fill the vacancy on motion of Mr. Morales, seconded by Mr. Miller.

There being no further nominations for Council Chairperson, the nominations were closed on motion of Mr. Morales, seconded by Mr. Miller. The motion carried by unanimous vote of Council.

Anthony Matula, 110 South Ninth Street, Lebanon, commended Council for the direction the City is heading and offered his support to Mayor Capello and Council. Chairperson Carey thanked Mr. Matula for his many years of support to the City of Lebanon.

Council voted on the appointment of Dan Bost to fill the vacancy on Lebanon City Council. Yeas--Mr. Miller, Mr. Morales, Mr. Wertz, and Mr. Carey, Chairperson--4; nays--none.

Chairperson Carey extended his thanks to all the candidates for stepping up and expressing interest in serving the community.
