2019 FALL YARD WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Collection shall commence Monday, October 14th at 7:15 AM Collection will be for one week only, ending Friday, October 18th

ALL CITY RESIDENTS ARE TO PLACE YARD WASTE CURBSIDE BY 7:00 AM, MONDAY, OCTOBER 14, 2019

While we ask that residents have their yard waste placed curbside by the first day of collections, city crews will be working the entire week collecting yard waste. Once an area is cleaned, no additional materials may be placed curbside for collection.

Yard waste materials must be placed in the street, one foot from the curb for collection. Vehicles must be parked at least 10 feet from the yard waste piles to allow room for city equipment to maneuver while cleaning up the yard waste. Branches longer than six feet in length and/or six inches in diameter cannot be accepted. Please do not block the storm sewers when placing items curbside for collection. The amount of material per household permitted for collection will be comparable to one pick-up truck size load. Material exceeding this maximum allowed amount will not be collected. In these cases, residents are encouraged to purchase an access card for the Yard Waste Recycling facility. Please contact the Department of Public Works for more information on obtaining this card at 717-228-4490.

Do not place materials curbside until the weekend prior to collection, October 11-13. In case of rain, this will help to prevent the chance of materials being washed into the catch basins and clogging the storm sewer drains. Do not place materials curbside after our crew has passed through your street. Our crew will make one pass on each street. If you miss this collection pass, the crew will not return. Please consider purchasing a Yard Waste Recycling Facility access card, if you have additional yard waste after the collection pass.

Collection will include hedge trimmings, branches and garden residue. Lawn grass, loose leaves, soil/dirt and non-organic material will not be picked up. The City's curbside leaf collection will commence on November 4. Please do not place bricks, pavers and other similar items in yard waste piles. Crews cannot see those items under the piles and the items could damage city equipment. These damages can be very costly, which ultimately costs the taxpayers. Please also make sure overhead trees have sufficient clearance. It is suggested that all trees are trimmed to a height of 14 feet from the street surface for equipment clearance. If you cannot provide an area free of this type of obstruction, then your materials should not be placed under low hanging branches or other impediments.
