



Q2 Choose Your Primary Residence:



Q3 Have you or family members in your household utilized the City's pool?



Q4 When was the last time you or a member of your household used the pool?



Q5 When open, how often would you say you or members of your household visit the pool during the swimming season?







Q8 How would you rate the quality of the existing pool?



Q9 How important do you feel it is for the City of Lebanon to provide an aquatic facility for its citizens and visitors?






