

## SECTION 00020 – ADVERTISEMENT AND INVITATION TO BID

Separate sealed proposals will be received by the City of Lebanon for the Bridge No. Leb-9 (N. 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. over the Quittapahilla Creek) Re-Decking Project and the Bridge No. Leb-12 (Partridge Street over Quittapahilla Creek) Re-Decking Project until 3:00 p.m. on Friday, March 23, 2018 at the City of Lebanon's Clerk's Office located at the Lebanon City/County Municipal Building, 400 S. 8<sup>th</sup> Street, Lebanon, PA 17042. The bids will be opened and read aloud at 3:15 p.m. in the City Council Chambers. Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check, bank cashier's check, trust company treasurer's check or bid bond (in the required form) for ten percent (10%) of the bid total.

The Bridge No. Leb-9 project involves debris removal from stream channel, curb and sidewalk repairs, the removal of existing pavement, re-grouting of shear keys, installation of a geotextile waterproof membrane and placement of a new bituminous wearing course on an existing pre-stressed concrete non-composite adjacent plank beam bridge.

The Bridge No. Leb-12 project involves vegetation and debris removal from stream channel, the removal of existing pavement, re-grouting of shear keys, installation of a geotextile waterproof membrane, replacement of signage and placement of a new bituminous wearing course on an existing pre-stressed concrete adjacent box beam bridge.
