2026 SPRING LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Collection shall commence Monday, April 13th, 2026 at 7:00 AM

The collection period will be for one week only in length, ending Friday, April 17th, 2026

**ALL CITY RESIDENTS ARE TO PLACE LEAF WASTE CURBSIDE BY 7:00 AM,
MONDAY, April 13th**

While we ask that residents have their leaf waste placed curbside by the first day of collection, city crews will be working the entire period collecting leaf waste. Once a street has been cleaned, no additional materials may be placed curbside for collection.

Residents may place unbagged leaves curbside beginning April 10th, 2026. Please do not place materials curbside until the weekend prior to collection period of, April 13th by 7:00 AM. In case of rain, this will help prevent the chance of materials clogging the storm sewer drains.

Do not place materials curbside after the city crew has passed your street. The crew will make one pass by each street. If you miss this collection pass, we will not return and recommend for residents to consideration purchasing an access card for the Yard Waste Center.

Leaves must be placed in the street, 1 foot from the curb for collection. Please do not place bricks, pavers and other similar items in the piles, as they could damage city equipment. Vehicles must be parked at least 10 feet from the leaf piles to allow room for city equipment to maneuver while cleaning up the leaf waste. Please do not block the storm sewers when placing items curbside for collection.

No Greenwaste materials may be placed curbside during this collection period. Please visit the City of Lebanon website for the 2026 city service schedule for more information on each of the seasonal collection periods.

City residents unable to participate in curbside collections may purchase an access card for the City of Lebanon Yard Waste Center located at 893 N. 8th Street. The initial fee for an access card is \$40.00 for residential yard waste; there is a \$35.00 renewal fee.
