- Lebanon Rescue Mission- Plan submitted and passed onto SESI for review and comment Letter. SESI letter has been drafted for Developer review. **Letter was sent to developer by SESI in last quarter of 2025. New plan addressing letter comments was submitted, but was not fully reviewed for comment prior to this PC meeting. Plan extension letter expires 9 March of 2026.**
- Washington Street Townhomes- intent to demolish the current structures on this lot and construct four townhomes in their place. This is located at 16<sup>th</sup> & Elder and Laurel Streets-Extended to May 8, 2023- **Plan extension has expiration date of 9 March 2026.**
- 725 N. 1<sup>st</sup> St.- Engineer comments provided to developer. Additional time being requested to address driveway & street access plans. **Plan extension has expiration date of 9 March 2026. Awaiting financial security and agreements from developer to be received.**

Review items:

- Lebanon Transit Authority- Larson Design Group- plans submitted for review. New Office, Garage, and Maintenance facility. **November 2025 meeting conditionally approved plan.**

**Solicitor review for plan has been completed. Comments for Developer agreement and O&M agreements forwarded on to engineer for finalization.**

- 1041 Maple St. Hutter's- Demolition and reconstruction of site building. Removal of tanks and pumps from flood plain, re-envision plot layout for customer safety and access. **New pump station is being installed, including pump canopy.**

**Land Bank Report:** No new updates to report. Lebanon Valley Economic Development Corporation exploring options to partner with Land Bank for potential procurement of properties for economic development possibilities.
